Rules and Regulation for Participation in Painting Competition and Poster Making Competition

Theme for both the competition: "Attainment of the food security for all through sustainable development."

On the Spot Painting Competition

- 1. Individual children/students, children from NGO may participate. Students from class 6th to 10th standards are eligible to participate in the competition.
- There is no registration fee to participate in the competition but students have to get registered by filling registration form which will be available on the Museums website and also at Museum reception from 27th of May onwards. Students may submit copy of their School I-Card/Aadhaar Card along with registration form.
- Last date for registration in the painting competition will be <u>13th of June</u>, <u>2015</u>.
- 4. Only drawing sheet will be provided to the participants from Museum. They have to bring their own drawing material for paining along with them.
- Competition will held on 17th June 2015 from 10:00 am to 12:00 noon at Indira Paryavaran Bhawan, Jor Bagh Road. Participants must reach the venue by 9.30 am.

Poster Making Competition on invitation basis

- 1. Students from 11th to Graduation final year will be eligible to participate in the poster making competition.
- 2. For participation, students may fill and submit the form which is available on the NMNH website and at the museum reception from 27th of May.
- 3. Participants may send their entries to National Museum of Natural History, Tansen Marg, Delhi-110001, <u>latest by 12th June, 2015 before 4:00 pm either by post or in person.</u>
- 4. Size of the poster should be 21.5"x15" (or half of the cartridge sheet).
- Participants will be required to submit a photo identity proof (either for standard in which he/she is studying) along with the poster and registration form.
