JOINING INSTRUCTIONS 65TH B.N. MULLIK MEMORIAL ALL INDIA POLICE FOOTBALL CHAMPIONSHIP-2016 TO BE CONDUCTED AT CHUMUKEDIMA, NAGALAND W.E.F. 4TH TO 19TH NOVEMBER, 2016

JOINING INSTRUCTIONS

1. INTRODUCTION:

Nagaland Police has been given the honour of organizing the 65thB.N. Mullik Memorial All India Police Football Championship – 2016 by the All India Sports Control Board(AIPSCB). The Championship will be held at Chumukedima, Nagaland from 4th November to 19th November, 2016. The Competition will be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations laid down by the All India Police Sports Control Board, New Delhi and FIFA.

2. VENUE:

The Championship will be held at Chumukedima Police Complex under Dimapur District, Nagaland. Dimapur is connected by air, road and rail. Chumukedima is 13 (thirteen) kms. away from Dimapur but the two towns are already joined by habitation and are actually twin towns. Chumukedima is at the exact foot-hill; the hill section enroute to Kohima along the National Highway-29 begins from Chumukedima.

3. GROUND CONDITIONS FOR THE CHAMPIONSHIP :

The matches will be played in the following grounds located within Chumukedima Police Complex.

- 1. Nagaland Armed Police Training Centre (NAPTC) Stadium.
- 2. Nagaland Police Training School Ground.
- 3. 1st NAP Bn. Ground.
- 4. DGP Football Ground.

There will also be three practice grounds.

- 1. Practice Ground 1 (Above DGP Football Ground)
- 2. Practice Ground 2 (Near Nagaland Police Central Canteen)
- 3. Practice ground 3 (15 NAP (Mahila) IR Ground)

4. CLIMATE:

Weather of Chumukedima will be pleasant during the day and cold at night/ morning during the season when the tournament is being conducted. Hence, warm clothing will be required. Temperature may range from 29° to 16° C.

5. TRAVEL GUIDELINES:

- (i) **RAILHEAD:** Dimapur is well connected by Indian Railways
- (ii) **AIR CONNECTION:** There is an airport at Dimapur and there are daily flights operated by AIR INDIA and INDIGO AIRWAYS. Flights operate to Dimapur from Kolkata and Delhi.
- (iii) **ROADWAYS:** National Highway 29 &37 link up Dimapur to the rest of the country.

6. PLACES OF INTEREST

The state of Nagaland, in north east India, is divided into eleven districts --Dimapur, Kohima, Mokokchung, Mon, Phek, Tuensang, Wokha, Zunheboto, Peren, Longleng and Kiphire. Nagaland makes an amazing tourist destination with its majestic hills and breathtaking valleys.

Dimapur serves as the main entry point to Nagaland. This is also the commercial center of the state. While nature lovers are enthralled by the scenic landscape of the place, history lovers are attracted to the 10th century Kachari ruins found here. Given below are some of the leading destinations here.

- i. Kachari Ruins located near Tourist Lodge in Dimapur dates back to the 16th Century A.D.
- ii. Dimapur Zoological Park is located 6 kms away from the township of Dimapur with a total area of 176 hac. The topography of the area is gentle rolling plateau with low lying area ideal for aquatic birds. Inaugurated on 28th Aug. 2008. Mission of Nagaland Zoological Park is to inculcate and develop a sense of caring towards flora and fauna.
- iii. **Green Park** is a cool place to relax or hangout for tourist as well as the locals alike. As its name amply implies it is full of Greenery. This park is located within the state Horticulture Nursery. A restaurant, resting shades and boating facilities inside the park provides you every opportunity to relax and enjoy
- iv. Hong Kong Market also known as the 'Fashion market' of Nagaland. A onestop shopping place for street wear. Generally bargaining starts at 70% of the stated price.
- v. **Hazi Park** is a wholesale market known for electronic goods and household items.
- vi. **Naga Super Market** has a number of Handloom emporiums where you can get Naga Ethnic products like traditional costumes, handicrafts and other souvenirs.
- vii. **Places to eat at Dimapur:** Aroma Eatery, Café 77, Ethnic Kitchen, Zephyr Lounge, KFC Dimapur, Bambusa, Korean Uncle Cafe, etc.

Kohima, the capital of Nagaland, is 61 Kms. Away from Chumukedima. Located at a height of 1,444m above sea level, Kohima has picturesque views to offer. Trekkers will love the place as there is enormous scope for trekking and camping. The top destinations in Kohima are -

- State Museum The State Museum offers a unique insight into the life of the Nagas. It displays the rich and varied artifacts, costumes and lifestyles of the various Naga tribes. There is also an art gallery by different local artists.
 Open Monday to Friday (and 1st and 3rd Saturdays of the month) from 9:30 AM 4:30 PM.
- ii. World War II Cemetery –The World War II Cemetery at Kohima is built at the location where a decisive battle was won by the Allied Forces during the Second World War, forcing the Japanese army to retreat. There are 1,420 Commonwealth burials of the Second World War at this cemetery, and a memorial to an additional 917 Hindu and Sikh soldiers who were cremated in accordance with their faith
- iii. **Khonoma Village -** Khonoma village is located about 20 km from Kohima. The village, referred to as Khwunoria is estimated to be around 700 years old and is spread over an area of 123 sq.km. The total population of the village is about 3000, settled in 600 households. Khonoma is famous for its forests and a unique form of agriculture, including some of the oldest terraced cultivation in the region. It is also known as the 'Green Village of India' for its effort on conservation of its forests and wildlife.
- iv. Kisama Heritage Village The Naga Heritage Village at Kisama is the venue of the annual Hornbill festival of Nagaland. Situated about 10 kilometers from Kohima, the Naga Heritage Village offers the panorama of Nagaland's tribal heritage and culture. The Heritage Village aims to protect and preserve all ethnic cultural heritages by offering a common platform. The Village also acts as a cultural showcase, which upholds and sustains the diverse, customs and traditions of all the ethnic tribes of Nagaland. One can see the cluster of 16 traditional houses or Morungs of each tribe built in typical architectural styles.

7. ELIGIBILITY:

As per the provisions of the rules of the All India Police Sports Control Board, this competition is open to all ranks. All State/UT Police Forces &CPOs are eligible to participate. The State/UT Police forces and CPOs should ensure that only those players are included in the team who are appointed on permanent basis of the organization. A certificate/undertaking to that effect should be furnished and attached with the entry form duly signed by competent authority (IGP) in respect of newly appointed players.

8. ENTRY FORM, NOMINAL ROLL & TEAM COMPOSITION:

Joining Instructions, Model entry forms & Travel Plan forms can be downloaded from the link '65th B.N. MULLIK MEMORIAL ALL INDIA POLICE FOOTBALL CHAMPIONSHIP-2016' uploaded in the Nagaland Police website – nagapol.gov.in . Two copies of entry form along with nominal roll and two passport size photograph of each participants and officials, duly filled in, may be sent by post to the Organizing Secretary, 65th AIPFC 2016, c/o Commandant NAPTC, Chumukedima, Nagaland, Pin No – 797103 or by email to <u>aipfc2016@gmail.com</u> so as to reach him on or before 1st October, 2016. A copy of the same may also be sent to the Secretary, All India Police Sports Control Board & Central Coordinating Committee, 25, Akbar Road, New Delhi -110011.

Any changes in the entry form should be conveyed to the Office of the Organizing Secretary at least 15 days before the commencement of the Championship failing which changes will not be entertained.

Entry fees of Rs. 50/- per participants including reserves, Managers, Coaches and Doctors should be deposited in cash on 3rd November, 2016 during the Team Manager's Meeting and Clinic.

The maximum strength of each State/UT Police/CPOs teams shall not exceed 25 members including the Team manager, coach and medical staffs. The strength of the playing team including the reserve should not exceed 20 members.

Entries received after 1st October, 2016 will not be entertained.

9. RECEPTION & REPORTING:

All the teams are requested to inform their travel plan well in advance for proper reception, transport and accommodation. There will be reception teams waiting to receive all teams at their point of entry/arrival provided travel plans in detail are intimated well ahead of time to the Organizing Secretary, 65th AIPFC 2016. **Participants are requested to make their return arrangements in advance so as to avoid any inconveniences**.

Teams are requested not to arrive before 29/10/2016 repeat 29/10/2016 and last date of arrival/reporting is 02/11/2016 repeat 02/11/2016.

10. ACCOMODATION:

All the participants will be provided with suitable accommodation. All the Heads of the State Police and CPOs are requested to issue instructions to their participants not to bring their spouses or families with them as the Organizing Committee will not be able to provide additional accommodations for the family members. The members should carry their own utensils, rations, bedding, mosquito nets, adequate winter clothes, etc.

The participating teams are requested to intimate rank-wise strength of officers and men who will be participating, reporting for the Championship on the proforma enclosed. This information may be sent to the office of the Organizing Secretary along with entry forms to make the requisite arrangements. Efforts are being made to accommodate gazette officers i.e. Dy.SP/Asstt. Comdt. and above in the Nagaland Police Officers' Central Mess, Chumukedima. The charges required to be paid will be intimated to them on arrival.

Non-Gazetted officers and men will be provided Hostel/barrack/dormitory/ accommodation at the venue of the competition.

10. MESS ARRANGEMENTS:

All the Teams are requested to make their own arrangements for the Mess. They should bring with them sufficient number of Cooks, Class-IV Employees, Utensils, administrative staff to establish their mess at the accommodation centers provided for them. Cooking gas and canteen burner will be made available on payment. An advance of Rs. 2,000/- has to be paid for this arrangement on arrival.

11. MEDICAL FACILITIES:

Medical Team with first aid kit and life saving drugs will be available at the venue of the competition. All participants should be medically fit and in possession of medical fitness certificate issued by an authorized medical officer.

12. SECURITY:

In order to ensure security, all the officials and members of the team will be required to always carry their Identity Card. Every member of the participating teams should bring with him two recent passport size photographs in uniform duly attested for the purpose of preparing Games Identity Card (Temporary ID) for the duration of the Championship. Due precaution must be taken against fire hazards and cause short circuit/careless disposal of cigarettes etc. Participants may also be advised to abstain from unauthorized movements without prior permission.

13. DISCIPLINE :

i) A very high standard of discipline is expected from all officers and men of the participating teams. Team Managers will be personally responsible for orderly conduct of their team members during the period of the Championship.

ii) The Jury of Appeal shall act promptly and impartially in all cases of indiscipline coming to its notice. At least one member of the Jury of Appeal shall always remain present during every event.

iii) The Jury of Appeal will be empowered to take disciplinary action including disqualification against any participant who is guilty of misconduct on the filing of written complaint by the umpires.

iv) The Jury of Appeal shall also take drastic action in case of proven guilty, which shall include a minimum punishment of deduction of maximum points, which are otherwise awarded in the event.

v) There will be Marshals to ensure proper discipline throughout the championship.

14. TRANSPORTATION:

Transportation facilities will be provided to the teams and Team Managers coming by road, rail or by air at Dimapur Bus Station, railway station and airport to bring them to their respective location of stay. The mode of journey, date and time of arrival at Dimapur by train/flight/road should be clearly communicated to control room by WT/Fax/Email for proper management of TPT accordingly.

However, the following police units of neighbouring states may bring their own transportation - (1) Assam (2) Manipur (3) Meghalaya (4) Mizoram and (5) Arunachal Pradesh. CRPF has a Group Centre at Khatkati about 5 Kms. from Dimapur, which may cater TPT requirement of CRPF contingent. Similarly, Assam Rifles may arrange their own TPT from nearby ARTC, Dimapur. BSF contingent may arrange TPT from their Rear Camp/Transit Camp, Dimapur.

15. CO-ORDINATION:

Participating teams are requested to designate a **senior officer from their respective States/UTs/CPOs as Liaison Officer** who can be contacted in case of any information required in connection with this Championship. The name, rank, Office address, e-mail address/telephone and fax number of the nominated officer may be communicated to this office at the earliest.

16. OPENING/CLOSING CEREMONY+ AND FLAGS :

The Opening Ceremony will be held on 7th November, 2016 and Closing Ceremony will be held on 19th Novemeber, 2016 at NAPTC Stadium, Chumukedima, Nagaland. The dress code for both the ceremonies will be as follows:

<u>For Team Manager & Coach</u> White shirt, grey trousers, navy blue blazers, service tie/service scarf and black shoes/sports shoes.

<u>For Players –</u> Track Suits or trousers and shirts as prescribed by their respective police organization.

Each team must bring with them their respective state police / unit flags of the following specifications.

i. Flag for hoisting	:	6'X4' =	1 No.
ii. Flag for March Past	:	3'X2' =	1 No.

17. REHEARSALS: There will be full dress rehearsals of both opening and closing ceremonies in accordance with the norms of the Police games. The rehearsals for the opening and closing ceremony will be held on the 6th November, 2016.

18. MANAGERS MEETING & CLINIC AND DRAW OF MATCHS:

A meeting-cum-clinic will be held at Rhododendron Hall, Officers' Mess, Chumukedima, Nagaland with Team Managers/Captain/Coaches at **1000 hrs. on 3rd November, 2016.**

The team grouping, fixtures and match schedule will be decided during this meeting-cum-clinic and these will be in accordance with instruction/guidelines as prescribed by the Championship Organizing Committee.

19. RULES AND CONDUCT OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP:

The Championship will be conducted as per the rules laid down by the All India Sports Control Board and FIFA. Protest, clarification if any should be lodged by the team managers in writing to the Organizing Committee within two hours after the completion of the match along with a protest fee of Rs. 500/-. The decision of the Jury of Appeal shall be final and binding on all the teams.

The Championship shall be played on league-cum-knockout basis with the preliminary rounds being pool-wise league and followed by knockout rounds to determine the Champion, Runner-up and Hardline teams.

Point during the league phase will be allotted in the following manner:

Winning Team	-	03 points
Losing Team	-	Nil
In case of tie	-	01 point to each team

20. PLAYERS OUTFIT:

- a) The basic compulsory outfit of a player shall consist of a jersy or shirt, shorts, stockings, shin-guard and footwear.
- b) A player shall not wear anything that may be dangerous to other players.

21. TEAM COLOUR & NUMBERS:

- a) Teams must declare their first and second colours (Jerseys) during the Managers' meeting and use only these colours during the Championship.
- b) Teams are obliged to bring along their first and second colours (Jerseys) in contrasting colours.
- c) Players shall wear registered numbers on their jerseys (back and front) and shorts. Numbers on the jerseys and shorts should be of contrasting colours and clearly visible and should be in accordance to the directives of FIFA and AIFF.
- d) Goalkeepers should wear jerseys of contrasting colours from the other outfield players and the referees.
- e) Any team found guilty of fielding players with jersey number other than the one he registers shall be liable to disciplinary action, including fines.
- f) In the event of clash of colours in a match, lots shall be taken to decide which team shall wear their secondary colours.


