EXAMINATION CENTRES

All District Head Quarters, important Taluqs and Mandals will be considered as the examination centres. If more than 75 candidates are appearing from any one place/school from rural areas, a separate examination center will be formed.

EXAMINATION FEE

Rs. 75/- will be charged for all, irrespective of the classes. An amount of **Rs. 10/-** may be deducted for each application to meet the examination expenditure. This includes the commission of DD to be sent to us and examination expenditure.

Send Rs. 65/- through Crossed Demand Draft drawn in favour of Wesley Educational Society payable at Hyderabad along with the application forms/Nominal Rolls. A single draft for all the pupils appearing from a school may be sent. Cash will not be accepted.

SPECIAL RECOGNITION
