- Teams will have to submit a one-page Executive Summary and a 10-15 slide Powerpoint Presentation through e-mail latest by February 19, 2018, 5 pm.
- The B-Plan should have following details:
 - A brief about the team members with contact details
 - Name of the venture
 - Competitive strengths of the venture
 - Competitors' strengths and weaknesses
 - Defined Target market with market analysis (market size & potential market share)
 - Marketing Plan (how do you plan to market your product)
 - Plans for Intellectual Property Rights (e.g., patents, licenses, etc.)
 - Plans to achieve milestones in next 6 months, 1 year and beyond.
 - The challenges that can be foreseen and plans to overcome them.
 - Projected Revenue Model (plan to generate revenue)
 - Funding Plans
 - Any other relevant input

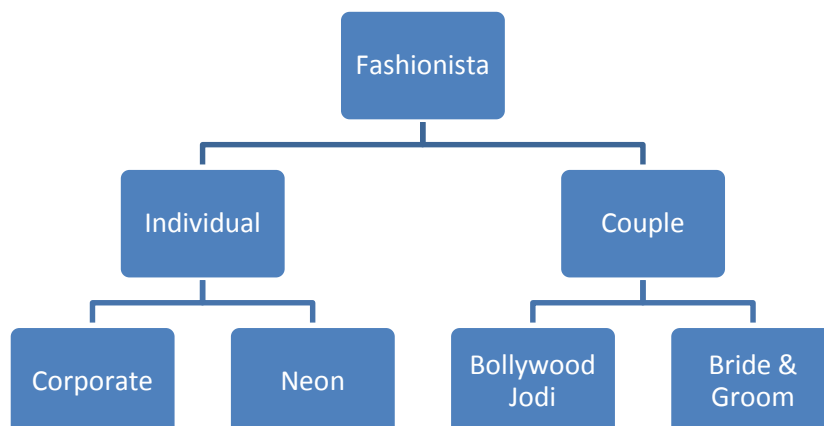

- If the rules are broken, the participant will be disqualified on the spot and he/she has to stop there itself without disturbing the other participants.
- **Note: Participation fee is Rs. 200/- per player and maximum 6 players can participate per college, with any combination of men & women.**
