

RULES AND REGULATIONS

ENTRY IN THIS CONTEST CONSTITUTES YOUR ACCEPTANCE OF THESE OFFICIAL RULES.

The CityMind 2016 Hackathon Challenge (the “Contest”) is a skill contest where participants must develop a solution (“Solution”) on their own idea. Solution that you develop will be evaluated by judges, who will choose the winner(s) in accordance with these Official Rules. The prize(s) will be awarded to participant(s) with the highest score for the judging criteria. See below for the complete details.

1. BINDING AGREEMENT: In order to enter the Contest, you must agree to these Official Rules (“Rules”). Therefore, please read these Rules prior to entry to ensure you understand and agree. You agree that submission of an entry in the Contest constitutes agreement to these Rules. You may not submit an entry to the Contest and are not eligible to receive the prizes described in these Rules unless you agree to these Rules. These Rules form a binding legal agreement between you and CityMind 2016 with respect to the Contest.

2. ELIGIBILITY: To be eligible to enter the Contest, you must be: (1) above 20 years old and below 30 year old at the time of entry; (2) resident of India; (3) not a person or entity under India’s export controls or sanctions; and (4) your education qualification should be doing or completed BE, BSC, BCA, MCA, MBA, ME, MS, and MSC.

3. HOW TO ENTER: COMPLETE REGISTRATION NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. To enter the Contest, visit the Contest website located at <http://citymind.in> (“Contest Site”) and submit your entry via the Registration submission form. After successful registration, you will be eligible to give online entrance exam in English. Once you successfully clear the exam, you are eligible for contest. Your entrance exam date and result will send through an email after registration.

You may enter as an individual or as a team of between 3(Three) to 6(Six) people. You must include all participants who created the Solution on your team. For individual entry, CityMind will build the team for you.

During the Contest Period, CityMind, its agents and/or the Judges (defined below) will be evaluating each registration to ensure that it meets the criteria listed below. CityMind reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify any entrant who submits a registration that does not meet the criteria.

4. JUDGING: Each entry will be judged by a panel of experts who are selected by CityMind (“Judges”). Each Solution will be evaluated by the Judges based on the following criteria

- **Originality:** How original is this solution compared to other products and platforms already available? The submission should provide a unique approach to solving the problem.
- **Security and User Privacy:** Where relevant, any necessary means to ensure user data is safe and kept private.
- **Scalability:** How easily could the application be scaled out to benefits our country and globally?
- **Impact:** What is the potential for the submission to drive immediate real world impact?

- **Functionality:** Working functionality of the application as submitted and potential for submission to be completed through to launch (this will take into account the demonstrated technical capabilities).
- **Design / User Experience:** How intuitive is use of the Solution?

Judges will evaluate each submission based on the above-listed criteria and will determine the winners.

5. TAXES: ALL TAXES IMPOSED ON PRIZES ARE THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE WINNERS. In order to receive a prize, potential winners must submit the tax documentation to the relevant tax authority. The potential winner is responsible for ensuring that (s)he complies with all the applicable tax laws and filing requirements.

6. GENERAL CONDITIONS: All state, provincial and local laws and regulations apply. CityMind reserves the right to disqualify any entrant from the Contest if, in CityMind's sole discretion, it reasonably believes that the entrant has attempted to undermine the legitimate operation of the Contest by cheating, deception, or other unfair playing practices or annoys, abuses, threatens or harasses any other entrants, CityMind team, or the Judges. No entrance fees (if any) will be refundable.

7. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS: By submitting a Solution in this Contest, the entrant warrants and represents that the Solution, including the programming and related material, is open source and is released subject to the Open Source Initiative approved licenses (<http://www.opensource.org/licenses/index.html>) and not subject to the proprietary rights of any person or entity.

8. PRIVACY: Participants agree that personal data entered during the registration, including name, mailing address, phone number, and email address may be processed, stored, shared and otherwise used for the purposes and within the context of the Contest. Participants also understand this data may be used by CityMind in order to verify an entrant's identity, postal address and telephone number in the event an entry qualifies for a contest.

9. PUBLICITY. By accepting a prize, entrant agrees to CityMind and its agencies use of his or her name and/or likeness and the Solution for advertising and promotional purposes without additional compensation, unless prohibited by law.

10. WARRANTY AND INDEMNITY: Participants warrant that their Solutions are their own original work and, as such, they are the sole and exclusive owner and rights holder of the submitted Solution and that they have the right to submit the Solution in the Contest and grant all required licenses. Each entrant agrees not to submit any Solution that (1) infringes any third party proprietary rights, intellectual property rights, industrial property rights, personal or moral rights or any other rights, including without limitation, copyright, trademark, patent, trade secret, privacy, publicity or confidentiality obligations; or (2) otherwise violates the applicable state, local or provincial law.

11. ELIMINATION: Any false information provided within the context of the Contest by any entrant concerning identity, mailing address, telephone number, email address, ownership of right or non-compliance with these Rules or the like may result in the immediate elimination of the entrant from the Contest.

12. INTERNET: You have to carry your laptop for the idea development. Contest Entities are not responsible for any malfunction of the entire Contest Site or any late, lost, damaged, misdirected, incomplete, illegible, undeliverable, or destroyed submissions or entry materials due to system errors, failed, incomplete or garbled computer or other telecommunication transmission malfunctions, hardware or software failures of any kind, lost or unavailable network connections, typographical or system/human errors and failures, technical malfunction(s) of any telephone network or lines, cable connections, satellite transmissions, servers or providers, or computer equipment, traffic congestion on the Internet or at the Contest Site, or any combination thereof, including other telecommunication, cable, digital or satellite malfunctions which may limit an entrant's ability to participate.

13. RIGHT TO CANCEL, MODIFY OR DISQUALIFY. If for any reason the Contest is not capable of clear the entrance exam, running as planned, including infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures, or any other causes which corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity, or proper conduct of the Contest, CityMind reserves the right at its sole discretion to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Contest. CityMind further reserves the right to disqualify any entrant who tampers with the submission process or any other part of the Contest or Contest Site. Any attempt by an entrant to deliberately damage any web site, including the Contest Site, or undermine the legitimate operation of the Contest is a violation of criminal and civil laws and should such an attempt be made, CityMind reserves the right to seek damages from any such entrant to the fullest extent of the applicable law.

14. FORUM AND RECOURSE TO JUDICIAL PROCEDURES: These Rules shall be governed by, subject to, and construed in accordance with the Indian Laws, excluding all conflict of law rules. If any provision(s) of these Rules are held to be invalid or unenforceable, all remaining provisions hereof will remain in full force and effect. To the extent permitted by law, the rights to litigate, seek injunctive relief or make any other recourse to judicial or any other procedure in case of disputes or claims resulting from or in connection with this Contest are hereby excluded, and all participants expressly waive any and all such rights.

15. ALCOHOL: There will be no alcohol served or allowed at the event.

Participants violating these rules may be asked to leave the Hackathon at the sole discretion of the CityMind organizers. Thank you for helping make this a welcoming, friendly event for all.
