NKRC 2015 Virtuals – Guidelines for participating teams

The Virtual Round is a pre-qualifier to participate in the NKRC 2015 main event and prime objective is to design the complete CAD Model of the Go-kart. The design should be complete in all respects to the extent of being considered ready-to-manufacturing. This event is scheduled on 18th & 19th July, 2015.

The teams will be selected based on their knowledge of the basic Automotive Design Technology and about the Go-Kart design and manufacturing requirements.

Time Structure for each team (Total 30 minutes per team)

- 1) 20 minutes: Presentation by team: No questions will be asked during presentation. Warning bell will ring after 15 minutes. Please make rehearsals to ensure that presentation will be over in 20 minutes. No extra time will be allowed beyond 20 minutes for any team.
- 2) 10 minutes: Questions by Judges, to be answered by team members.
- 3) There can be minimum 2 members and maximum 5 members in the presentation hall, no other member except these would be allowed to enter in the presentation hall.
- 4) Presence of Team Captain OR Vice-Captain is mandatory.
- 5) All the members representing a particular team must come in exactly same dress code (team uniform/t-Shirt/Shirt): This dress code will be unique for that team. It would be suggested, if the team members adorn their institute logo or team logo.

Presentation Guidelines

- 1) For the first time participants, max number of slides is 14 including the introduction and thank you slide. For the teams who have participated in NKRC 2014-15 (Season-1) will have to add an additional slide(Total 15 including the introduction and thank you slide) mentioning at least 10 significant design changes (engineering point of view) from last year.
- 2) During the presentation, team will be judged, based on their basic understanding of automotive engineering and fundamental principles covering entire vehicle and all important aggregates. Showing extensive design calculations is not necessary at this stage. It is important to show clarity of understanding basic design approach/principles.
- 3) Innovation does not carry any score as such during Virtual round. However, weightage will be given during selection if new innovative feasible ideas are showcased.
- 4) Faculty Advisor, if present, will be silent observer & will not participate in Presentation by team or any discussions with Judges.







Structure of Presentation: (Slide Sequence)

Note: Use Font Style "Calibri" and the Font Size as "12 or above".

- 1) Preliminary Technical Specifications & Overall Performance Targets. 2D / 3D views of the proposed Go-Kart design.
- 2) Knowledge of rulebook Main dimensions/structural and safety requirements / material of roll cage.
- 3) Design Methodology for Roll Cage, Proposed Engineering process for FEA load cases and constraints, meshing size, solver used, criteria for Factor of Safety & deformations. Actual FEA results may be presented but not mandatory.
- 4) Ergonomics knowledge related to vehicle cock pit lay out Driver seating lay out, ease of egress, vision, reach and controls.
- 5) Steering Design Methodology & considerations for selection of steering system, turning circle, Steering ratio, Turns lock to lock, Steering angles Inside and outside, Steering wheel diameter, Steering wheel torque etc.
- 6) Brakes Design Methodology & considerations for brakes, type selection (Disc / drum brakes), brake circuit lay out/actuation, Stopping distance, deceleration, pedal effort etc.
- 7) Power train (Engine to wheel including tyres) & mounting / packaging considerations, Transmission unit-Geared / CVT / Centrifugal clutch / any other, tyre size, Vehicle performance prediction e.g. minimum torque required, Vehicle speed, Acceleration etc.
- 8) Manufacturing processes required for various important vehicle aggregates, machine tools/hand tools and other facilities required. Facilities available in the college workshop.
- 9) Technical parts list for the vehicle (BoM): Overall weight and cost elements/ estimates and financing for the project.
- 10) Team size, Responsibilities assigned (team structure), Project Plan including Validation test schedule.
- 11) Design verification/Quality process and Validation procedure (Road Tests etc.) plan up to main Event (DVP).
- 12) DFMEA
- 13) This slide will include 10 significant design changes from engineering point of view. (Only for the teams who have participated in previous year's event)

Reporting and decorum Guidelines:

- 1) All the members of the team have to report and get registered before 11:00 AM on the day of their presentation. All the teams must report at auditorium one hour prior to their slot timing.
- 2) If a team fails to report on the designated time, that team would be evaluated at the end of the complete Morning/Afternoon slot, as applicable. (As per the feasibility of the organizing team)
- 3) The presentation must be in both PowerPoint 2003 and PDF format, mailed at NKRC@Virtualis.in. This should reach us on or before 16th July evening 5pm. Please keep the subject line<Team ID No.> <Team name>. You are also required to bring the complete presentation (in both the formats) in a formatted Pen Drive. Failing which, the teams would face disqualification from the event.

All teams must carry the following things and produce them at the time of their registration:

- 1) College ID card
- 2) Passport size pictures
- 3) An MS Excel Sheet stating the names of the team members the way they want it on the certificates.
- 4) Two hard copies of the presentation, to be presented in front of judges along with the soft copy of the presentation in a formatted pen drive.

It's a humble request to the teams to kindly come to the venue in strictly accordance to their respective slots as allotted.

Please make sure that you confirm to all the above mentioned rules and regulations.

Non Compliance will lead to unwanted actions, including disqualification.
